

Cookie Policy

Our website uses cookies to distinguish you from other users of our website. This enables us to provide you with a good experience when you browse our website and also allows us to improve our site.

A cookie is a small file of letters and numbers that we store on your browser or the hard drive of your computer if you agree. Cookies contain information that is transferred to your computer's hard drive. By law, we are permitted to store cookies on your machine providing that they are essential to the operation of the site ("Strictly necessary cookies" as set out below), but for all other we need your permission to do so.

We use the following cookies:

- **Strictly necessary cookies.** These are cookies that are required for the operation of our website and the platform on which it runs.
- **Analytical/tracking cookies.** These allow us to recognise and count the number of visitors and to see how visitors move around our website when they are using it. This helps us to improve the way our website works, for example, by ensuring that users are finding what they are looking for easily.

We do not use cookies for the purposes of marketing automation or retargeting. You can find more information about the individual cookies we use and the purposes for which we use them in the table below:

Cookie Preferences	_ocvb-keep-banner-closed; _moove_gdpr_popup	This cookie is used to store your acceptance of the cookie notification and retention of your preferences on the website itself. It will expire in 1 year.
